Subject: US Army COE – Huntington District Restrictions

PURPOSE

This SUBNOTE provides notification of restrictions for submersible operations in waterways under the jurisdiction of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Huntington District. This includes water bodies in Kentucky, Ohio, Virginia, and West Virginia. The notice is intended to assist operators in planning safe and compliant submersible activities.

APPLICABILITY

This notice applies to all PSUBS-affiliated submersible operations. Compliance is strongly recommended for all submersible operations regardless of affiliation.

PROCEDURE

Submersible operators are required to review and familiarize themselves with the **“Policy on Use of Manned Submersible Vessels for Recreational Use on Corps Lakes within the Huntington District”** (CORPS-POLICY), as published by the Department of the Army, Huntington District, Corps of Engineers. A link to the document is provided under the Resources section below.

At least five days before commencing scheduled submersible operations, a representative shall submit the Dive Plan Notification as defined in Appendix A of the CORPS-POLICY.

REQUIRED INFORMATION

1. Dive Plan.
2. Emergency Plan.
3. Contact information for all participants.
4. Dates of Operation.
5. Intended boat ramps.
6. Dive site location.
7. Submersible description.
8. Surface boat description.
